If you or someone you know has been sexually assaulted, we can help. Here are your options:

Options	Who to Speak With
Option 1:  Confidential Resource  Information regarding alleged sexual misconduct that is shared with these individuals cannot be shared with others without written permission except if there is a professional duty to warn (if there is a threat to harm self or others and/or if there is a report of child or elder abuse).	<ul> <li>You can call Counseling (609) 343-5667</li> <li>Counseling will recommend visit to health services and provide professional referrals.</li> <li>Counseling will provide short term assistance with victim/ survivor to deal with emotional toll of experience. Will provide referral for long term counseling if desired. Will educate victim/survivor on reporting options.</li> </ul>
Option 2:	Call Safety and Security (609) 343-5125
